Abstracts (approx. 2000 letters), together with the author's brief CV, e-mail address and phone number must reach the Program Committee latest by **November 30th, 2018**. Electronic submissions please send in format DOC, RTF, HTML, PDF or ASCII. Contributions shall respect the target audience, and must be original and independent.(non-commercial).

Authors will be notified whether their abstracts have been accepted by **December 17th, 2018**. Drafts of accepted papers (in the text form, approx.7000 letters) must reach the Program Committee by **January 31st, 2019** for final evaluation. Results of the evaluation will be announced by **February 22nd, 2019**. Only a limited number of best papers will be selected and included in the conference proceedings. Authors must submit the final version of their paper to the Program Committee Proceedings before **April 25th, 2019** in Czech or English version. IS2 is an international independent summit, therefore all presentations are required to be submitted on the provided IS2 slide-deck template with deadlines by **May 23rd, 2019**. If the required materials would not be sent according to the above-mentioned terms, the lecture may be refused.
